Thanks to those of you who were able to join us for the March meeting. Prof Astrid Berg shared a fascinating presentation from the Zero to Three conference, which looked at the impact of the quality of the language environment on the learning of infants. To sum up, children who are exposed to <u>quality</u> language (not just quantity) have potential to learn better at school. Vocabulary matters, so reading has to be promoted. Dual languages are beneficial.

This month we will be heading out to the Northern Suburbs for the first time to network with like-minded professionals. Much interest has been shown in infant mental health so this is an opportunity to support the northern suburbs. Dr Anusha Lachman, will be presenting on *'The Shared Pleasure Paradigm. Exploring infant resilience in babies of mothers with severe mental illnesses'*. Dr Lachman is a child and adolescent psychiatrist at Stellenbosch University and a consultant in the Adolescent Inpatient Service and the Paediatric Consultation Liaison Service at Tygerberg Hospital. She is also the co-convenor of the new Master's Program in Infant Mental Health. Dr Lachman is completing her Ph.D and involved in research around maternal and infant psychiatry, paediatric neuropsychiatry and resilience. This presentation is relevant and should stimulate an interesting discussion.
