SLEEPING LIKE A BABY - What is that ? BY DR NILS BERGMAN

This presentation will examine the neurological basis for how sleep develops, as well as the role sleep plays in neurodevelopment.

Dr Bergman introduced Kangaroo Mother Care to South Africa in 1995. He was Senior Medical Superintendent of the Mowbray Maternity Hospital (7000 deliveries per year) Dr Bergman continues to live and work in Cape Town, as a Consulting Public Health Physician. He is also an Honorary Research Associate at the University of Cape Town, South Africa. Apart from his original degree, he holds a Diploma in Child Health, a Masters degree in Public Health, and a Doctoral degree in Clinical Pharmacology. He is married to Jill, who works in her own capacity on their team promoting awareness of the infant's needs.
